WSAVA VACCINATION GUIDELINES GROUP

REPORT TO ASSEMBLY 2015

Since the 2014 Cape Town Congress, the Vaccination Guidelines Group (VGG) has concluded its third phase project with the publication of vaccination guidelines for veterinarians in Asia. The guidelines document is published in the *Journal of Small Animal Practice* and available on-line from the WSAVA website. The results of the 2-year project and summaries of the Asian guidelines will be presented during a lecture stream during the Bangkok Congress.

The VGG has now begun its Phase IV Project – a revision and update to the current 2010 global guidelines, due to be released in late 2015.

The membership of the VGG for the phase IV project is: Professor Michael Day (University of Bristol, UK; Chairman), Professor Ron Schultz (University of Wisconsin-Madison, USA), Professor Marian Horzinek (Utrecht University, The Netherlands) and Professor Richard Squires (James Cook University, Australia).

The VGG held its first Phase IV meeting in August 2014 and a second in April 2015. The draft document has been worked on extensively between meetings by electronic exchange.
